BOOKS

The Song of the Seed: A Monastic Way of Tending the Soul by Macrina Widerkehr

A "retreat in a book" structured around three ten-day sequences of scripture excerpts, with guidance for sacred reading as an individual or in groups.

The Return of the Prodigal Son by Henri Nouwen

Nouwen ponders Rembrandt's painting and the parable of the Prodigal Son, showing how deeply one can enter into a sacred work of art.

Praying with Jane Eyre by Vanessa Zoltan

An "atheist chaplain" and divinity school graduate relates how life lessons learned from her favorite book led her toward techniques for seeing any book as a sacred text.

Open Mind, Open Heart by Thomas Keating
